DC/20/2834/ARM - The Haven 2 Kents Lane Bungay NR35 1JF - Approval of Reserved Matters of Outline Permission DC/20/0221/OUT - Construction of 1 no. new dwelling and garage with a dropped kerb off Beccles Road. - Details relating to the layout, scale, appearance, and landscaping of the site

It was proposed by DO'N, seconded by BP,, and unanimously RESOLVED that these plans are recommended for REFUSAL with the following comments.

- There are concerns regarding the drainage on this site and more information is required
  on how the problem of drainage is being dealt with. It is noted that Anglian Water are
  not noted as consultees and that they have not submitted any comments with regards
  the suitability of this application. The existing garden in this site currently acts as a
  partial soakaway and there is concern where surface water will go with this additional
  building being built.
- There does not appear to have been a Full Planning Application passed for this
  development and only Outline Permission granted (DC/20/0221/OUT). Therefore more
  details are required of the building works including what the brick wall shown on the
  plans at the rear of the proposed development is for.
- There have been historical drainage problems with this site, and surrounding area, which has resulted in flooding. It is also noted that the drainage system in this area combines both sewerage and surface water.
- In view of the above concerns more information is required on this application.

DC/20/2622/LBC - 33 - 35 Upper Olland Street Bungay Suffolk NR35 1BE — Listed Building Consent - Replace rotten first floor window at rear of property. Existing window is fairly modern C1960's / 70's and beyond repair. Propose to replace like for like.

It was proposed by BP, seconded by LH, and unanimously RESOLVED that these plans are recommended for APPROVAL with the comment that it would be nice to see a replacement window in the character of the building rather than a like for like replacement.
